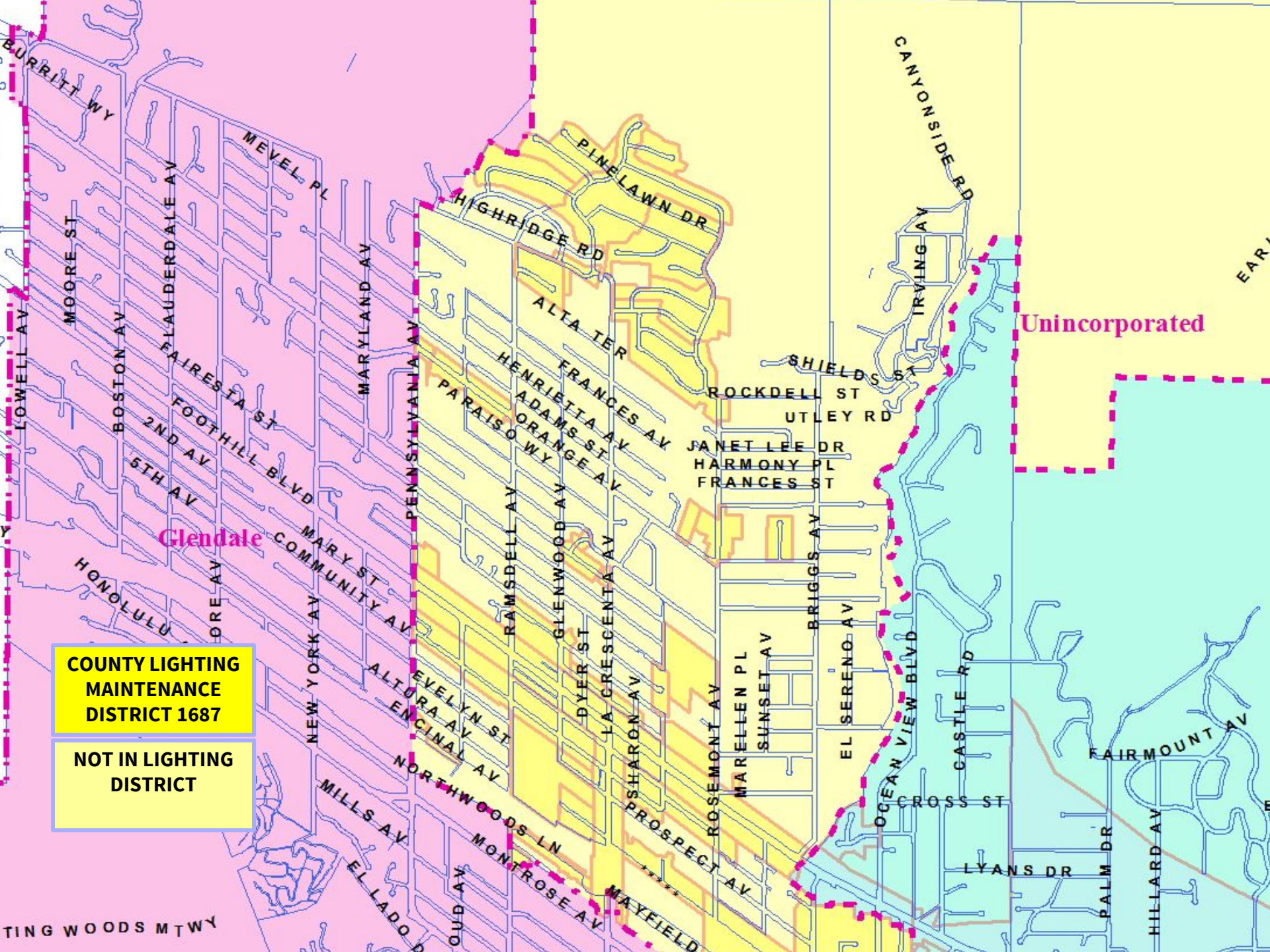

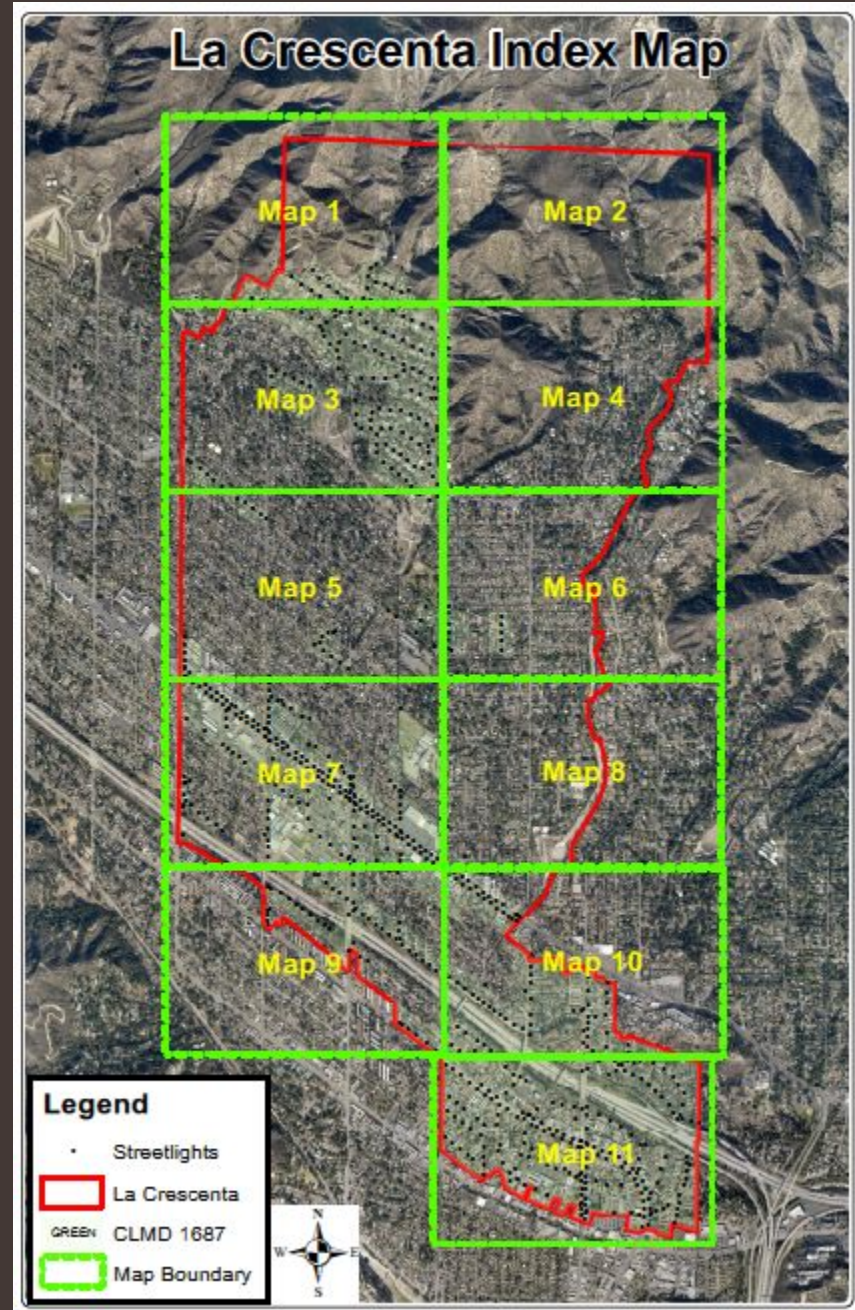

County Lighting Maintenance District

- 686 streetlights in the La Crescenta area
- Sidewalk index map of the La Crescenta area
- Funding for the operation and maintenance of existing streetlights
- Assessment for streetlights in the unincorporated area is \$5 per single family home and proportionately higher for other land use
- New annexation and installation of streetlights



STREETLIGHT DESIGN GUIDELINES

- Illumination Engineering Society guidelines to provide the level of lighting level recommended.
- Flat cut-off lense
- LED standard lamp
- Wood poles at no cost
- Concrete and decorative at cost

HOW TO OBTAIN NEW STREETLIGHTS

AREA NOT IN THE LIGHTING DISTRICT

- Request Department of Public Works

Contact Street Lighting at (626) 300-4726 or

- No cost for streetlight on wood pole, concrete pole at cost, \$5 annual assessment
- Petition 60% or more from the benefiting property owners in favor of the annexation and streetlights
- Community meeting
- Public Hearing (45 day public hearing notice)
- Majority Protest proceeding (Proposition 218)
- Ballots. Require more in support of annexation than protest against based on ballots submitted
- DPW to proceed with the installation upon no Majority Protest

HOW TO OBTAIN NEW STREETLIGHTS

AREA IN THE LIGHTING DISTRICT

- Request Department of Public Works
- Petition required for 3 or more streetlights
- Majority Protest proceeding not required

RESCINDMENT OF PETITION

- Request Department of Public Works
- Petition sponsored by a member of the community
- 60% or more signatures from benefiting property owners in favor of rescinding the original petition
