Glendale Unified possible Territory Transfer: Suggestions were made by several Board members to take the Mountain Avenue Park off the table as too many residents and parents objected to the sale of the property. They are now talking about new boundary lines for Monte Vista, and possibly Freemont Elementary to fill the seats of those children that would leave and go to La Canada schools. The new boundaries would phase in just as the kids would phase out of Mountain into La Canada. GUSD promises more community outreach as the changes become more permanent.
