Re: Service changes Metro Bus line 91

Dear Ms. Ramos,

The Crescenta Valley Town Council understands the need to make corrections to the 91 bus route due to safety issues at the Ocean View/Honolulu intersection. However, we feel there needs to be a compromise to sustain the 91 route so the following needs of the community are maintained - access along Honolulu westbound and northbound La Crescenta Avenues, as well as access through the Montrose Shopping Park.

The Crescenta Valley Town Council would like to suggest the following:

1. Reroute the 91 northbound using the "Sunday Farmers Market" route with the addition of two bus stops on the northeast corner of Florencita/Ocean View and the northwest corner of Orangedale/Honolulu.
2. Option 1 above is temporary until Metro and The Montrose Shopping Park can establish an alternate route that maintains service through the Montrose Shopping Park allowing for continued service along Honolulu Avenue, then northbound on La Crescenta Avenue.
3. Postpone any changes until Metro can collaborate with the City of Glendale and The Montrose Shopping Park to devise viable options so service is maintained through the shopping park as well as on Honolulu and La Crescenta Avenues.

Elimination of the 91 route or the duplication of the line using the Montrose Avenue route are not viable options for our community. The 91 in its entirety serves our elderly and a great deal of students who access this line from La Crescenta Avenue. The elimination of this line will create an unnecessary hardship to our community.
