DONATIONS POLICY

The Crescenta Valley Town Council is a popularly elected, non-profit, IRC §501(c)(4) social welfare organization operated exclusively to promote and support its responsibilities to:

- Provide a forum, through a town meeting, to identify and discuss the issues of concern to the residents and businesses in the unincorporated areas of La Crescenta and Montrose (census tracts 3001, 3002, and 3005), and to represent those residents and businesses.
- Work together with government bodies and agencies, as well as local agencies and organizations, to meet the needs of the community.
- As funds allow, provide high school students from the unincorporated areas of La Crescenta and Montrose with scholarship opportunities based on local community service. (Children and grandchildren of any current Town Council member are not eligible for scholarship funds.)

The Council does not fund:

- Individual pursuits
- Third-party organizations raising funds for charity with the exception of those organizations who provide direct assistance to the Council in performing its responsibilities to the community
- Multi-year projects or commitments
- Religious organizations with the exception of secular activities open to those of all faiths such as allowing the use of their facility for Council elections or fundraisers
- Political or advocacy groups, private schools, pre-schools, elementary and high schools
- Endowment or capital campaigns
- Conference, seminars, events or golf tournaments
- Groups who primarily operate outside of the unincorporated areas of La Crescenta and Montrose
- Travel-related events, including student trips or tours
- Sports teams or leagues
- Fundraising activities, including sponsorship of tables, contests, door prizes, raffles, auctions or advertising
