



General Council Meeting Minutes

September 17, 2020

1. Flag Salute: Lead by Councilmember Stupakis
2. Call to Order & Welcome: President Leon, 7:04 p.m.
3. Roll Call: Recording Secretary Daniel Kim - Present: Leon, Kim, Libra, Hoffman, Stupakis, Ear, Beatty, Rabinov, Ordubegian. Not Present: Gonzalez, Beatty, Rodriguez, Yu.
4. Approval of August Meeting Minutes as revised, motion to approve by Ordubegian. Seconded by Ear. Approved unanimously.
5. Approval of August Agenda as amended moved Stupakis by, seconded by Ear. Approved unanimously.
6. President Leon gave a community announcement about public dumping. He urged the community to respect the streets and to take proper measures to dump legally. Thoughts and prayers go out to the two sheriff deputies that are in the hospital after the recent shooting.
7. Community Reports (3 min and questions)
 - a. Youth Council – Seline Hemelians gave updates on how the Youth Council is operating under current conditions. Also gave updates on upcoming event ideas. Their first virtual event, October 8th, will be the GCC President speaking event.
 - b. CHP – Shared statistics for the month of August.
 - c. Sherriff – Deputy Emily gave crime statistics for the month of July. Answered questions from the council. Answered questions from the council.
 - d. CVWD – Mr. Ochon gave updates on the passed bond for infrastructure improvements. Construction will begin immediately. A local hazard mitigation plan is underway. It includes input from members of the community. Funded by the federal government. Answered questions from the public.

- e. CV Fire Council – Paul Dutton gave updates on their roles during the current fires. CV Fire Cert has been keeping in touch with surrounding Fire Councils on the status of the Bobcat Fire. Mr. Dutton has been urging preparedness in case of possible evacuation. Jennifer Dutton (disaster program coordinator for our area representing the Red Cross) has been managing evacuation centers for the Bobcat Fire. They also do accept pets. Answered questions from the council.
- f. CVCA – Grant Michaels gave updates on upcoming zoom meeting. Their agenda is discussing on going land use projects. Answered questions from the council. No updates on the Rockhaven property.
- g. GUSD – Vivian Ekchian gave announcements about ongoing services available to students at this time. All public health guidelines are being adhered to. Jennifer Freemon gave updates on school fields availability for the public and school sports. Everything regarding athletics will need to be outdoors. Answered questions from the public.
- h. Land Use Committee – Ines gave updates for several issues that came up after their last meeting. Questions to the county regarding interim hosing policy was brought up. Churches can be made potentially available for overnight parking which affects our community. A potential letter idea regarding these policies was proposed to the council. An update on the Briggs / Foothill project was briefly discussed. This project needs to comply with the 2006 CSD. October 1st is the next LUC meeting. Answered questions from the council.

8. Community Announcements (2 minute)

- a. Library: Martha Wiggins gave updates on library current status. Sidewalk service is going well. Tuesday October 27th will be an outdoor flu shot event being held at the library. Answered questions from the council.

- a. Paul Dutton asked about the possibility of bringing hiking trails into debris basin by the county and his concerns regarding such project.
- b. Mike Leum commented on the possibility of the Eagle Canyon Wash Trail and concerns regarding such project being implemented. Also commented on some increased graffiti in the area and questioned who should be in charge of graffiti removal.

10. Council Business

- a. Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report was circulated by email. Ordubegian moved, Rabinov seconded. Approved unanimously.
- b. Correspondence: All mail was picked up and distributed.
- c. Streets and Transportation: Meeting will be held on the 29th at 6PM via zoom.
- d. Eagle Canyon Wash Trail: Email regarding this project was circulated to the council. Council gave their opinion about the project.
- e. Election: Ordubegian, Ear, and Leon are forming this year's election committee. Depending on the availability of St. Lukes for outdoor voting, the application is pending.
- f. 9/11 Parade: Council participants gave a recap on the 9/11 parade. Despite the bad air quality, it was a success.
