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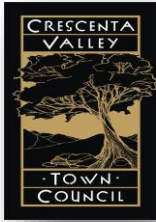

- I. Welcome/Introductions- Desiree Rabinov –Attendees: Council: Desiree, Chris Kilpatrick, Harry Leon, Donna Libra. County staff: Shirley Lai, and Jonathan Gonzalez. Residents: Liz Benbrook
- II. Agenda overview/additions/changes-None were presented.
- III. Update on Open Issues
 - a) County DPW staff liaisons/ CVTC updates- Jonathan Gonzalez reported on the remaining streets that have been under review since last year and are nearing a final report and findings.
 - County DPW staff-CVTC Streets/Intersections list update, report findings and site visits conducted and outcomes. Briggs/Los Amigos bulb-out installation. The summary of the matrix is attached that shows the closed-out requests in orange with the final recommendations. Several priority streets are under investigation highlighted in blue. And there are other streets that were previously studied with no improvements are reactivated for another study.
 - Discuss New requests from Community and Council- No other requests were submitted.
 - b) Orange Avenue Pedestrian sidewalk survey outreach schedule – Shirley Lai reported for Andrew Ross that an outreach Zoom meeting will be held for the Orange Avenue/ La Crescenta Avenue ped-intersection plan to the community slated for May 19th at 6pm. Desiree will confirm with Chamber and CVTC calendar for no conflicts and report back to Shirley. Flyers will be provided to post.

- c) Metro Open Streets Grant application timeline update and route- Shirly Lai reported for John Burton on the progress with the Metro grant application. It's currently under agency review for cost estimate and to finalize a cooperative agreement with the City of LCF. The route is finalized and will be submitted to circulate with the minutes for council for review and any comments.
- d) Soundwall additional funding agreement Measure R update- Shirley reported for Ricardo Gordillo that the funding agreement is still under development with Metro and for programming it with Caltrans for the Design/build contract. Desiree asked that we have an opportunity to review the Soundwall design before it gets finalized. Shirley will request any developments to be shared general council.
- e) Foothill Blvd., Compete Streets -LA County Master Plan development timeline and process by County Staff- Shirley reported for Andrew Ross that staff had a successful meeting with the Cities of Glendale and LCF to be partners with the development of the study. Existing conditions report is underway. A draft will be available around August 2021.

Measure M funding update infrastructure improvements - Shirley had no new information.

V. New Business

- a) County Vision Zero Slow Streets update-Shirley Lai shared Matt Dubiel's PowerPoint (attached) on the increasing slow streets signs that have been installed in La Crescenta. The number of streets has expanded to about 30% from last month. Great response from residents and are happy with the results.
- b) Crosswalk enhancement examples- Jonathan will investigate further about innovative designs and pavement enhancements (i.e., colored patterns treatments) that have been implemented elsewhere. One concern the County has is the funding for those improvements. Desiree suggested to investigate Prop A or C local return which is the half cent sales tax generated in our area per capita allowable for street improvements where transportation corridors are located.
