Statement of the Crescenta Valley Town Council

The Town Council held a Special Meeting on Monday 12 April, 7:30pm, at St. Luke's of the Mountains Episcopal Church, for which notice was given at least 72 hours in advance to review in-person the investigative committee report on the alleged infractions to Council by-laws of 1st Alternate Councilmember Johnny Brookbank.

At said meeting the following motion was moved by Councilmember Kerri Lewin and seconded by Councilmember Desiree P. Rabinov, by a vote of 9 out of 9 members present (3rd Alternate Councilmember Ted Yu and 2nd Alternate Councilmember Jo Ann Stupakis were absent, while 1st Alternate Councilmember Johnny Brookbank was barred from voting per by-laws as he was the subject of the investigation) which exceeds the 2/3 passage requirement per by-laws for disciplinary action:

Motion - General censure in accordance with the by-laws – An immediate suspension and censure in accordance to the by-laws until June 30th. In the event of a further violation of the issues raised in the investigative Committee's report, immediate removal will be effectuated and decided by the Executive Committee.

Mr. Brookbank has waived confidentiality on release of this Statement and the Investigative Report.
