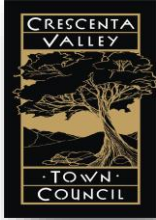

- I. Welcome/Introductions- Attendees: Council-Desiree Rabinov and Residents: Cathi Comras, Liz Benbrooks, Dede Mueller, and Estineh Mailian. County staff: Shirley Lai and Jonathan Gonzalez
- II. Agenda overview/additions/changes- No suggested changes were provided.
- III. Update on Open Issues
 - a) County DPW staff liaisons/ CVTC updates- Jonathan Gonzalez
 - County DPW staff-CVTC Streets/Intersections list update, report findings, and site visits conducted and outcomes. Jonathan Gonzalez provided raw data for the three streets with speed hump requests, and the counts were performed in April 2021, which was during the COVID restrictions. Desiree requested to have those streets recounted when schools are in regular sessions after restrictions are lifted. Desiree will provide staff with the GUSD schedule. The street matrix is attached.
 - Discuss New requests from Community and Council- No new recommendations were provided.
 - b) Orange Avenue, La Crescenta Pedestrian improvements and Pavement resurfacing Update and Grant application for Stormwater Capture dry wells and bioswales project on Prospect Ave and Mira Vista – Shirley Lai reported for Andrew Ross that they are finishing the project concepts by summer, and in Fall they will be finalizing the design.

- c) Metro Open Streets Grant application timeline update and project costs- Shirley Lai reported that they hired a consultant to assist staff in developing cost estimates and a realistic timeline for implementation. Desiree asked when the application dates are and do they need support letters for the grant application. This information will be available at the July meeting.
- d) Soundwall -Metro additional funding agreement update- Shirley Lai reported for Ricardo Gordillo that Metro is going to the board in July with the Amendment for additional funding. She will have more information at the August meeting.
- e) Foothill Blvd., (Glendale, La Crescenta, and La Canada) Compete Streets LA County Master Plan- Existing conditions draft report -Shirley Lai indicated that there would be a project website with project documents and to obtain feedback this summer. The findings and existing conditions report will be ready late summer or early Fall.
- f) Measure M funding update AVCJPA-Short Range Transportation Plan projects - Shirley Lai had no updates.

V. New Business

- a) County Vision Zero Slow Streets update-Shirley Lai provided the PowerPoint presentation with new figures for new and total signs in the El Caminito (30 signs), Pinecone (9 signs), and Briggs Terrace (21 signs) sections. The PPT is attached.
- b) Crosswalk enhancement examples- Desiree Rabinov provided a link before the meeting on the City of Glendale's updated Pedestrian Master plan, which has pilot projects to paint and enhance crosswalks like artwork and other street improvements beyond the traditional regulations. County Staff indicated that they need to determine the process to develop guidelines and procedures to avoid vandalism and look into Glendale's examples.

Curbs and gutters w/o sidewalks. 2.SRTS sidewalks for Mountain Avenue Elementary- County staff will report back on their discussions with other departments to determine the next steps for both items at the July meeting. Additionally, a resident will give a presentation regarding the Mountain Avenue Elementary sidewalk request for further discussion.
