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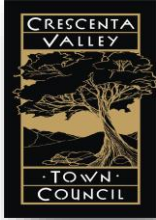

- I. Welcome/Introductions- Desiree Rabinov welcomed attendees. Present: Councilmembers; Chris Kilpatrick, Carin Hoffman. Residents: Liz Benbrooks, John R., Matthew Yorks. County Staff: Shirley Lai and David Lee.
- II. Agenda overview/additions/changes-None were provided.
- III. Update on Open Issues
 - a) County DPW Traffic staff liaison - David Lee reported that the new traffic counts would be conducted for all the streets on the matrix during COVID. And staff will coordinate it around the school's schedule that Desiree provided from GUSD. He anticipates receiving those data reports by mid-Nov to December 2021. The street matrix was updated on when data counts will be available, including outstanding items under review for a staff determination.
 - County DPW Traffic staff update-CVTC Streets/Intersections list update, report findings, and site visits conducted and outcomes. Updates are included in the attached street matrix form.
 - Discuss New requests from Community and Council- No new requests were submitted.
 - b) La Crescenta Avenue Pedestrian improvements and Pavement resurfacing Update and Grant application for Stormwater Capture drywells and bioswales project. - Shirley Lai reported for Andrew Ross that staff would be doing a field survey in the next month of the bulb out locations during the school commute times to assess the intersection vehicular turning movements whether a traffic study is required or not. Staff will also evaluate and measure the parking lane in



how it is used as a right lane. Staff will return to Council to provide a report on their fieldwork and recommendations.

- c) Soundwall project -Metro additional funding agreement and design update. Shirley Lai reported for Ricardo Gordillo that the Metro funding agreement is in process. He will provide related documents that reflect the program funding dedicated to the Soundwall project at the next meeting.
- d) Foothill Blvd., (Glendale, La Crescenta, and La Canada) Compete Streets LA County Master Plan- Website and Existing conditions draft report. -Shirley Lai reported for Andrew Ross that the website is slated to be up by November, and the community outreach process will be starting this Fall. All documents and notices will be posted on the website, and residents may submit comments as well online at the site. A site link will be provided to share with the community.
- e) Safe Routes to School application update- Shirley Lai indicated no new updates and will have more information at the December meeting. Currently, the timeline to submit applications is midyear in 2022.
- f) Electric Vehicle Charging Station Presentation for County public and Business facilities- **Laura Iannaccone, Mgr. Environmental Initiatives**, County ISD, Energy & Environmental Services- 15 min. This item was tabled for the November meeting due to the absence of the presenter.

- a) County Vision Zero Slow Streets update-Shirley Lai provided an update of additional Slow Street signs installed for a new street network referenced as Community avenue.
