RE: La Crescenta – Montrose Transportation Improvements

Dear Supervisor Barger,

We write to you in regards to the proposed La Crescenta – Montrose Transportation Improvements Project. The Council is in support of upgrades to pavement and sidewalks. Any water capture features for the benefit of the water table are encouraged. The Class II and III Bike lanes that were discussed in the presentation would be a welcome addition to our community.

Regarding the Pedestrian Improvements along La Crescenta Avenue the Council respectfully requests that the County take into consideration that continental crosswalks would be first preference at the locations of Orange and La Crescenta Avenue and El Caminito and La Crescenta Avenue. However, if the County deems that bulb outs are necessary to ensure the safety of pedestrians at these locations then the Council supports them. We ask that the County takes specific notice of the storm water drainage which can be extensive along La Crescenta Avenue particularly at these intersections during times of heavy rainfall. Additionally, the topography with downhill speed should also be a factor when placing pedestrians closer to the travel way. We ask that the County consider all factors when deciding which features would be of the highest benefit for our community.

The Council is in agreement that the intersection of Mountain Pine and La Crescenta is not a high pedestrian cross point and that a continental crosswalk would be fitting.

Should the County have the budget within the project, the Council requests that the intersection of Henrietta Avenue and La Crescenta Avenue be considered as an additional location for a continental crosswalk as this intersection serves as an access point to Two Strike Park and as a cut through to Monte Vista Elementary School and therefore pedestrian crossing is frequent at this location.
