It was brought to the attention of the Council that an anti-Semitic symbol was discovered within our community. The Council located the graffiti and advised the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works who has removed the graffiti.

The Town Council, working closely with 5th District Supervisor Kathryn Barger's office and the Crescenta Valley Sheriffs' Station, reminds our community that the Council has always stood against racism, discrimination, and bigotry in all its forms and expressions. In 2017, the Council voted to approve the following proclamation.

Whereas, the Crescenta Valley Town Council, as a self-governing, advisory body to the Fifth Supervisorial District of the County of Los Angeles operating pursuant to its bylaws and the laws of California, recognizes and embraces its responsibility to promote equality for all its citizens, residents and visitors; and

PROCLAIMS THAT:
