- 1. Call to Order & Welcome by President Baghdassarian: 7:03 p.m.
- 2. Flag Salute: Led by: President Baghdassarian
- 3. Invocation: Led by: Elizabeth Ahlers
- 4. Roll Call: Recording Secretary: Jeffrey Rodriguez Present: Leon, Rodriguez, Baghdassarian, Libra, Mueller, Kilpatrick, Kim, and Lewin Not Present: Ordubegian
- 5. Approval of the <u>Amended April General Meeting Agenda</u> (item 7 to item 5, item 8 to item 6, and item 6 to item 7) <u>Motion</u> to approve by Councilmember Libra, Seconded by Councilmember Kilpatrick . Approved Unanimously..
- 6. Approval of May General Meeting Agenda, moved by Lewin, seconded by Libra, Approved Unanimously.
- 7. Councilmember Leon presented a thank you certification to Elizabeth Ahlers for her service on the council. She spoke a few words to the public.
- 8. Scholarship committee presented scholarships to 5 community students. Councilmember Lewin said a few words and presented awards.
- 9. Approval of March Meeting Minutes Motion to approve by Councilmember Libra, Seconded by Councilmember Mueller. Approved Unanimously.

10. Community Reports:

a. Sheriff – Deputy's gave updates. Went over local crime statistics and an update for the potential flock system.

- b. CHP Update by Officer Keller Gave traffic reports on total crashes. Gave a notice to the public that the summer season is here and with end of the school year, be more careful. Answered questions from the public.
- c. CV Chamber Mary O'Keefe gave updates about the hometown country fair.
- d. GUSD Dr. Kelly King Assistant Superintendent Gave facility updates. Gave updates about the rewards Crescenta Valley achieve recently. Many of their clubs have brought back significant achievements. They also warned about the use of E Bikes and driving at the end of the year. Answered questions from the council.
- e. Land Use Committee Vice President Rodriguez invited everyone over to the next Land Use Committee meeting. The main subject matter is a potential development that is proposed to take over an easement in the area.

- a. Library: Ms. Martha Wiggins gave the following updates Library is getting ready for the summer reading program. She told a story of Asian Pacific Islander American History Month banner. - 12. CV Water District had a presentation to go over proposed rate increases. Proposed 8% rate increase over the next 3 years. Explained where the costs are coming from. There are costs they can not control. They will also try to do more inhouse projects to try and save costs. Two other meetings are being held to inform the public and answer any questions. Answered questions from the public and the council.
