

2025 Crescenta Valley Town Council Election Absentee Ballot Request

To be eligible to vote in the Crescenta Valley Town Council election, one must be a registered voter according to the current Registrar-Recorder's voters list or must be able to provide proof of registration prior to the election and must be a resident in the <u>unincorporated</u> area of La Crescenta-Montrose.

Absentee ballots will only be mailed to registered voters who request a ballot by (1) mail to the Council's post office box or (2) hand delivery to the acting election chair. Verbal requests will not be honored. You must submit a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope with sufficient postage in order to receive your absentee ballot by mail.

Requests for an absentee ballot must be received by the Council on or before **October 25**, **2025**

Only absentee ballots returned that have been requested by mail or hand delivery to the election co-chairs, Jeffrey Rodriguez, Dede Mueller and Chris Kilpatrick, will be valid.

The following form or a note containing the following information can be mailed to the Town Council or hand delivered to the acting election chair to request an absentee ballot.
