5. Approval of June General Meeting Minutes – Motion Libra, second Kilpatrick, unanimously approved.
6. Approval of July agenda – Motion Brautigam, Second Mueller, unanimously approved.
7. Community Reports
 - a. Sheriff – Sergeant Lee – June report – June report – Part 1 – no murders, rapes, robberies, burglaries, assault, arson, 8 larceny, 1 grand theft auto. 1 vandalism, 0 narcotics, 3 fraud ID thefts. 87 citations and 51 warnings given. Citations decreased 106 in May to 87 June. Residential and non-residential burglaries lower. No catalytic converter thefts.
 - b. Los Angeles Fire – Maria Grycan – June 75 responses. 1 fire (vehicle fire wb 210 at Pennsylvania) 62 medical responses, 63 patients seen. No service calls or hazardous, 12 no emergency. 5 traffic collisions, 1 vs. bicyclist at Foothill and Pennsylvania. Safety tip – stay hydrated, protect against heat related injuries. Question: More fires this year. Answer: Yes. Most are in Antelope Valley.

 - e. CVWD – Armineh – Painted fire hydrants between La Crescenta and Rosemont and Las Palmas and Ocean View – 250 anniversary partnered with girl scout troops. Pipeline updates – Teasley Street – Briggs and Rosemont – near completion water main installed. Henrietta Pennsylvania and Glenwood – one month more, Montrose Avenue Ramsdell and Del Mar – projected to break ground in September, may be later. Foothill between New York and Glenwood and Rosemont and Briggs – start September 20 thru January. Question: Can you suspend work on the first week of school. Answer: We always coordinate with the schools.
